Service Summary: The VOLUNTEER is responsible for assisting in the day-to-day lifeguard duties (except life-saving skills) and to teach the Five Core Values: Caring, Honesty, Respect, Responsibility, and Faith.

Service Requirements:

- Ages 14 & 15
- Treat all program participants, members and staff with respect regardless of race, religion, or culture.
- Possess energy, enthusiasm, and a positive attitude.
- Provide customer service to members utilizing the indoor and outdoor pool areas.
- Learn lifeguarding expectations.
- Assist with swim tests.
- Monitor waterslide use.
- Portray a positive role model for youth by maintaining an attitude of respect, loyalty, patience, integrity, courtesy, and maturity.
- Commit to assisting a minimum of twice/week unless otherwise specified by department director.
- Support the authority of the lifeguard.
- Wear a white-shirt and red swim trunks or red one-piece swimsuit.
- Report any injuries and/or unsafe conditions immediately to the sports department.
- Adapt to changing work conditions.
- Performs all other duties as assigned
