Service Summary: The VOLUNTEER is the main contact person for his/her team and relays important information from the sports department to the team. The VOLUNTEER will organize and attend our (1) practice and one (1) game per week during the season.

Service Requirements:

- Treat all program participants with respect regardless of race, religion, or culture.
- Possess energy, enthusiasm and a positive attitude.
- Coordinate practices with Youth Sports Director and participant parent or guardian.
- Communicate determined practice schedule (including location and time) to participant parent or guardian.
- Be punctual and attend all practices and games or coordinate a substitute coach for practices or games coach is unable to attend.
- Use positive techniques of guidance, including positive reinforcement and encouragement rather than competition, comparison or criticism.
- Portray a positive role model for youth by maintaining an attitude of respect, loyalty, patience, integrity, courtesy, and maturity.
- Contact team members in a timely manner with new information provided by the youth sports department.
- Support the authority of the officials assigned to each game.
- Wear YMCA coaches shirt provided by the Y to the first practice and all games.
- Conduct my practices and games so that all players have an opportunity to improve their skill level through active participation.
- Report any injuries and/or unsafe conditions immediately to the sports department.
- Adapt to changing working conditions.
- Performs all other duties as assigned.
